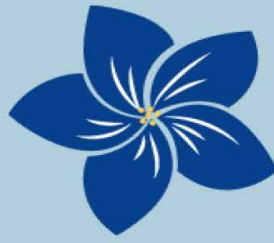

## MISSION STATEMENT

The Alzheimer's Aid Society exists to provide support, education and compassion to patients and caregivers throughout the journey of Alzheimer's disease and related dementias.



## WHAT WE DO

**SUPPORT GROUPS** -Support to those dealing with multiple specific dementia types. Alzheimer's is the most widely recognized and accounts for 60% of diagnosis, it is only one type of dementia.

**LEGAL ASSISTANCE**- Families are faced with legal decisions before Alzheimer's steals a loved one's sound judgment. The society offers free consultations for legal questions that arise during the aging process.

**MINI -SERIES** – Community based informational presentations provided by experienced peers to help provide resources, advocacy and outreach.

**"FORGET-ME-NOT- CLUB"**- A group for caregivers and loved ones occurs concurrently. This unique experience provides patients the opportunity to explore brain-stimulating activities while their caregivers receive respite and engage with other caregivers, creating an environment of mutual understanding and support.
